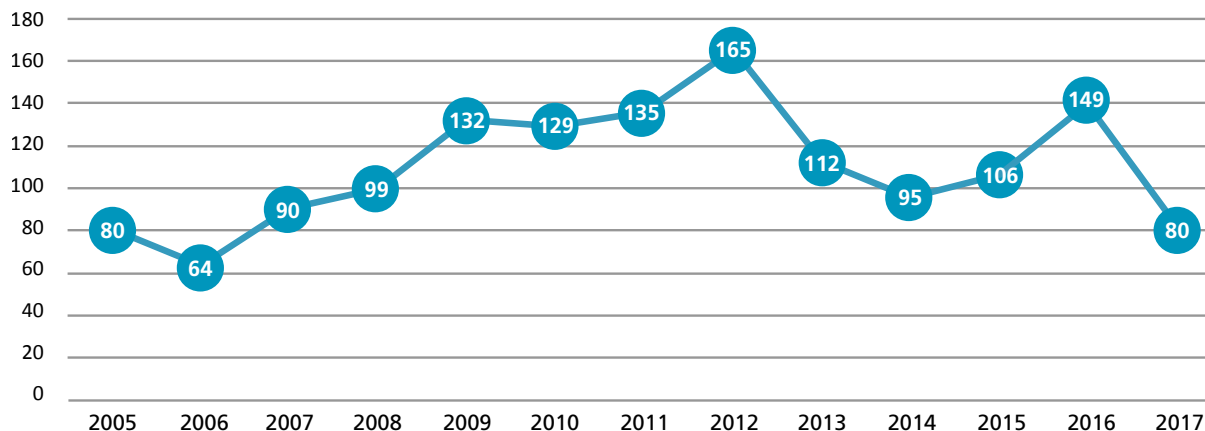

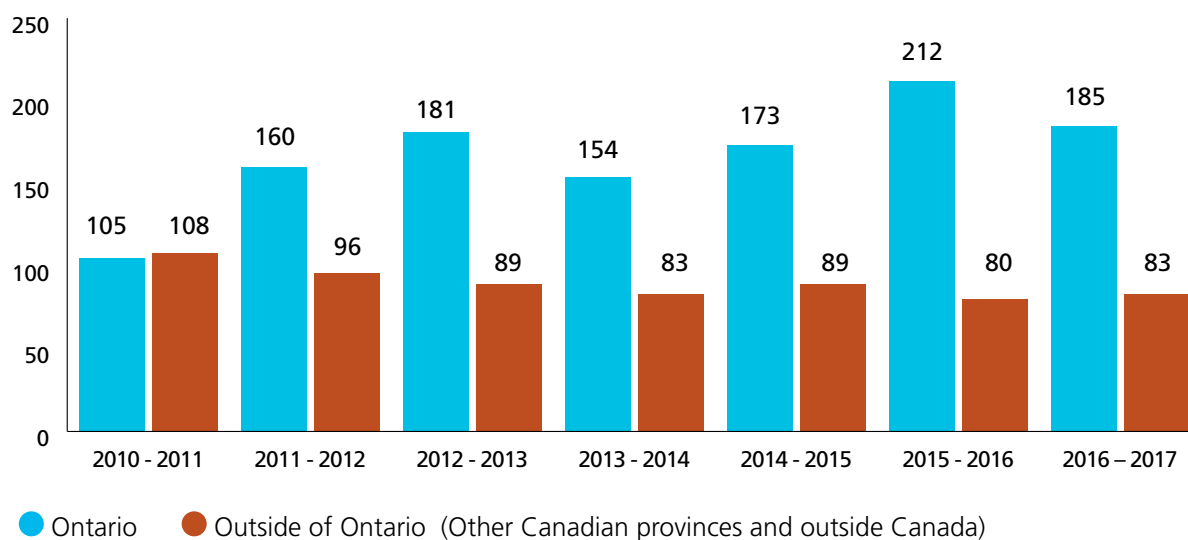
Net increase in membership



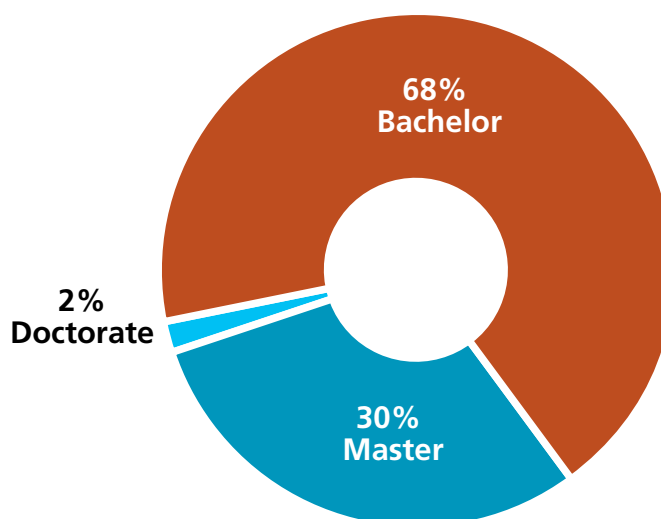

New members by place of education (2010–17)

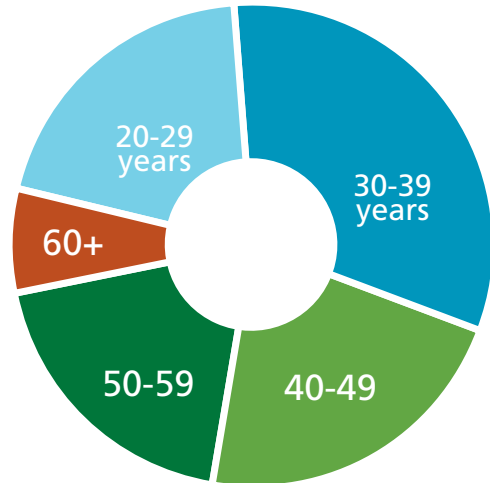


Education level of members

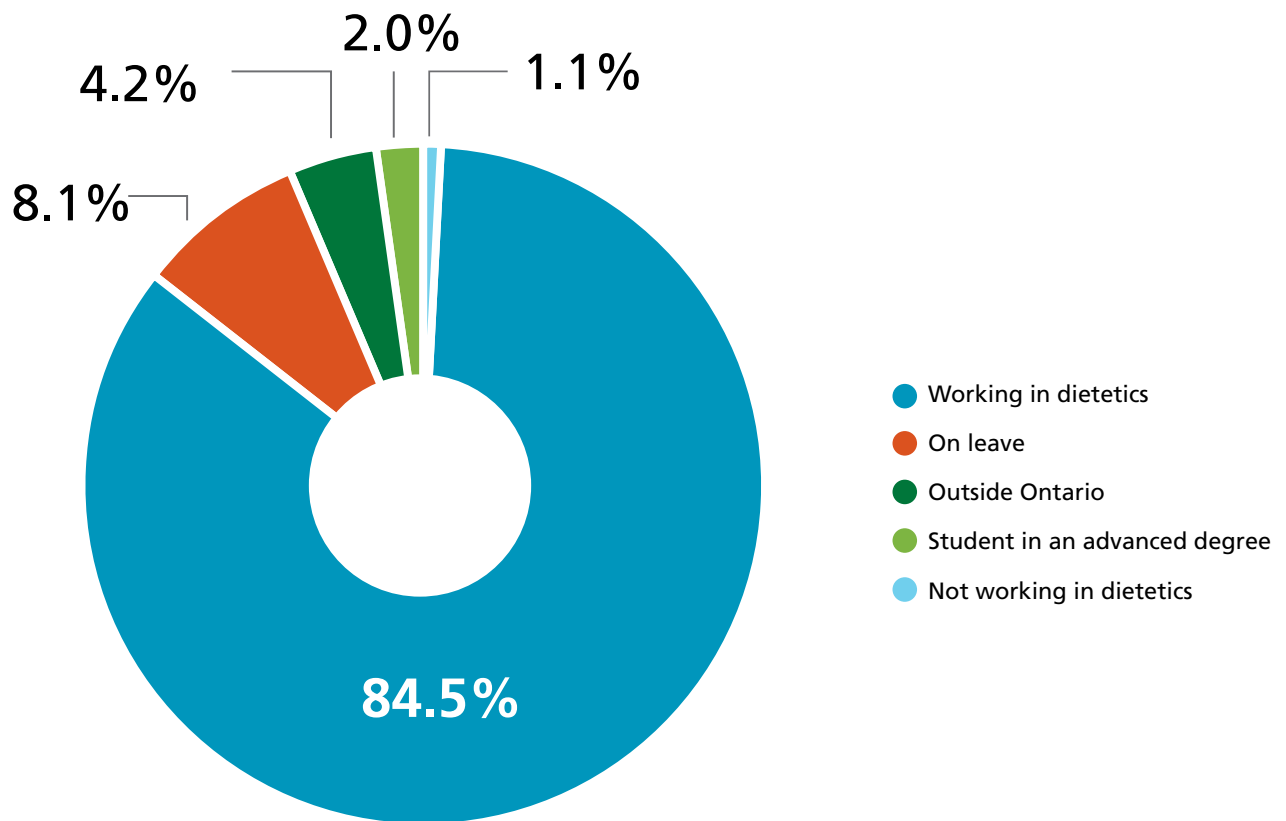

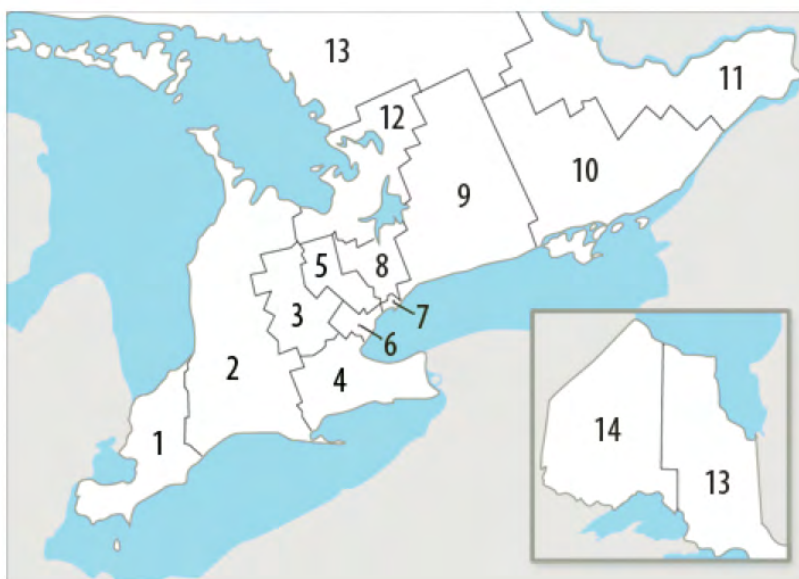
